“Willamette River to Main Streets” Day Trip

The **Willamette River** is a cornerstone of Oregon, flowing 187 miles from Eugene to Portland with many twists, turns and surprises along the way. When paired up with the friendly local mainstreets in Milwaukie, Oregon City, West Linn, and Lake Oswego, you are in for a perfect day of small town charm and water delights.

Milwaukie

Begin your day in beautiful Milwaukie, known for its dogwood trees and 20+ vendors at the **Milwaukie Farmers Market**. Every Sunday from May - September you can find produce perfect for a picnic, fresh cut flowers, gift items, and delicious prepared foods. We recommend picking up some breakfast here and taking it across the street to enjoy along the river at **Milwaukie Bay Park**. Not visiting on a Sunday? Not a problem! There are great coffee shops and cafes in town for take-out breakfast treats. We recommend **Ovation Bistro** or **Gramma's**.

Lake Oswego

Don't miss a stop at **The Rogerson Clematis Garden** on your way to Lake Oswego where you can stroll paths through over 850 varieties of clematis flowers, making this one of the most comprehensive clematis collections in North America. Feeling a bit peckish? There are a bunch of great outdoor dining experiences in Lake Oswego, like **Pizzeria sul Lago**, or opt to get dinner to go and enjoy at a nearby park. As you walk through downtown, you will find yourself in an outdoor art gallery! Admire **Gallery Without Walls**, a rotating series of sculptures as you make your way back to the Willamette River to end your evening riverside at **Foothills Park** or **George Rogers Park**.

West Linn

Time to cross the river over the **Arch Bridge** and head to West Linn for a relaxing glass of wine at **Campbell Lane Winery**. Wine not your preferred beverage? Check out **Historic Willamette Main Street** for great beer and cider options.

Oregon City

After filling up on breakfast it's time to adventure south along the river to Oregon City where you can rent a SUP or kayak (or join a tour) with **enRG Kayaking** and paddle all the way up to iconic **Willamette Falls** along the Willamette River Trail. Next, head to newly opened **Corner 14 Food Carts**, located next door to **OC Brewing** and **Tony's Fish Market**. Corner 14 has lots of socially distanced outdoor seating to choose from. While in town, check out main street for shopping or maybe a ride on the **Oregon City Municipal Elevator**. Visiting on a weekend? Don't miss the **Museum of the Oregon Territory**.

“Lower Mt. Hood” Day Trip

Mt. Hood is often known for its high elevation adventures, but have you explored the base of the mountain yet? The rivers, forests, and small town charm flow down to the base of Mt. Hood, inviting visitors in to explore and rouse all their senses in what this area has to offer.

1 Boring

Start your day in the least boring way possible at **Boring Bean** in Boring, OR. Enjoy locally roasted coffee and fresh baked pastries in an idyllic outdoor garden setting to charge up for a day full of fun. Before entering the base of Mt. Hood, it is vital to learn all about the local inhabitants, which means a visit to the **North American Bigfoot Center**. Here you can learn how to spot a Bigfoot track, hear what they sound like out in the wild, and find out where the latest local sighting was.

2 Choose Your Adventure

Now that you are charged up with caffeine and a good understanding of the local fauna, you can choose from a number of outdoor adventures the base of Mt. Hood has to offer with options for all skill levels and abilities.



Hiking

Enjoy a hidden gem hiking trail like the 4 miles of easy old growth forest trail at **Eagle Fern Park**, or the 14 miles of varied trail at **Milo McIver State Park**. Don't forget to pick up your 10 essentials at **Next Adventure** in Sandy.



Kayak/SUP'ing

Estacada Lake's still water is perfect for first time and experienced kayaking and SUP with access points at **Milo McIver Park** and **Timber Park**. Schedule a tour or rent your equipment at **Clackamas River Outfitters** in Estacada.



Mountain Biking

Rent or buy mountain bike equipment at **Mt. Hood Bicycle** and hit the trails at **Sandy Ridge Trail System**. Trails for all skill levels will wind you through a world-class riding experience in beautiful Oregon forests.

Sandy

Time to refuel after a morning of adventure. Fill up your belly and soul in Sandy with lunch at the **Sandlandia Food Carts** or dine outside at one of their many outdoor patios throughout town. Don't miss the best view of Mt. Hood in town at **Jonsrud Viewpoint**.

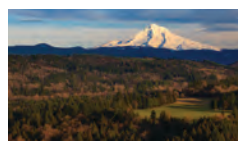

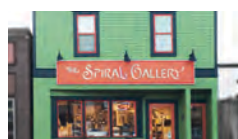

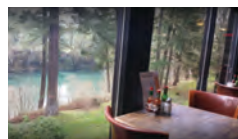

“Go Hog Wild in the Willamette Valley” Day Trip

The **Willamette Valley**'s lush farmland not only makes for idyllic scenery. It is also home to many charming farms along the **South Clackamas Farm Loop** as well as the communities of Molalla, Canby and Wilsonville. If you're looking to get up close and personal with friendly animals, this is the perfect place for you. Plus, it's a foodie paradise with true farm-to-table opportunities.

Wilsonville

For even more farmyard variety, take the Farm Walkabout at **Frog Pond Farm** where you can visit and feed their llamas, pigs, camels and more! Brews and bites await to finish your day. **Vanguard Brewing** offers craft beers like their WiggleButt IPA, lovingly named for the owners' beagle. Download the **Mt. Hood Territory Tap Trail** for discounts at Vanguard and more local breweries. For dinner, you will feel transported by the sights, smells and incredible flavors at **Dar Essalam** Moroccan restaurant.

Molalla

Kick off the day with a visit to the historic Prairie House Inn and enjoy coffee and light breakfast at **Cowboy Coffee** inside this B&B converted from a historic house originally built in 1900. Next, make some fluffy new friends at **Alpacas at Marquam Hill Ranch** and shop their collection of alpaca wool goods. All aboard! If you're visiting on a weekend, get your ticket to ride at **Pacific Northwest Live Steamers/Shady Dell Train Park** where you can take a ride through their park atop a small-scale train. Or if human power is more your thing, head over to the **Molalla River Recreation Area** and discover the secluded **Molalla River Rim Trail**, a moderate 6.5-mile loop hike with lots of old growth shade for a sunny day.

Canby

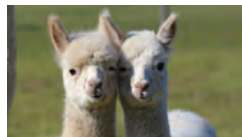
As you head for Canby, make a stop at **TMK Creamery**. They'll introduce you to their "Cowlebrity" dairy cows, and you can taste their incredible cheddar cheeses made on site. Pro Tip: Make an appointment for a truly behind-the-scenes tour. Treat yourself to dessert before lunch with a quick stop at **Puddin' River Chocolates**. The perfect spot for scratch-made lunch can be found at TMK Creamery (on the weekends) or try the sandwiches, salads and more at **Fir Point Farms**. Refuel in their charming outdoor dining area and then visit their tree climbing goats! Head to downtown Canby for unique shops from **The Book Nook** filled with a vast selection of books to **Retro Revival** for vintage retro furniture, art and clothing.
